Going Deeper in "What is a Plumb Line?" Read the following a few times:

Amos 7:7-14; Prov 14:12; 1 John 1:9; Joel 2:13

Reflect on the following:

Theme: Building Your Life Straight with God

- 1. Have you ever used a level or a measuring tool? Why do you think God uses a "plumbline" in this vision?
- 2. Why is it important to have a strong spiritual foundation? What helps you build that?
- 3. Why is it important that God cares about sin? What happens if we ignore the things that are wrong in our lives?
- 4. Have you ever felt like God was trying to get your attention about something in your life that needed to change? What was that like?
- 5. Why do people sometimes make excuses instead of dealing with their sin? What excuses do we hear today?
- 6. In verses 10–13, the priest Amaziah tries to shut Amos up. Why do you think people sometimes avoid hearing the truth?
- 7. Have you ever had a time when someone didn't want to hear the truth—even if it was helpful? What happened?
- 8. Amos says he's not a prophet by training—he's just a shepherd. What does that tell you about how God uses people?
- 9. What would you say if someone asked you why you believe in God or follow Jesus?
- 10. What's one part of your life—attitude, words, choices—that you think God wants to "straighten out"?

Challenges

- Ask God to show you one sin in your life that you've been ignoring or excusing. Be honest with Him in prayer. Name it. Confess it. Ask for His forgiveness and strength to turn away.
- 2. Make a bold move this week to cut off something that leads you into sin—whether it's a toxic app, a hurtful habit, or a friend group that pulls you down. Take a step toward holiness.
- 3. Write out a short prayer of repentance—your own words to God. Say you're sorry, ask for a clean heart, and commit to live differently. Then read Psalm 51 and let it guide your prayer.
