Going Deeper in “Are You Making a Difference”

Read the following slowly a few times:

Colossians 3:23-24 Hebrews 10:24 Matthew 5:16 James 2:17

Reflect on the following:

1. How am I continuing to do good, even when I do not immediately see results?
2. In what ways am I staying faithful and steadfast in serving God and others?
3. Who in my life may need encouragement, kindness, or support from me right now?
4. Am I allowing discouragement to keep me from making a positive difference?
5. How can my daily actions reflect God’s love in my church, family, workplace, or community?
6. What gifts or talents has God given me that I can use to help others?
7. When have I seen God use small acts of faithfulness to create a bigger impact?
8. Am I serving with joy and purpose, knowing that my labor in the Lord is never in vain?
9. How can I remain patient and hopeful while waiting for the “harvest” God promises?
10. What is one practical way I can make a difference for someone this week?

Challenges for the Week:
