

Going Deeper in "Jesus Went Out"

Read the following a few times:

Acts 11:1-18; Revelation 21:1-6; John 13:31-35

#### Reflect on the following:

- 1. Why do you think Jesus talks about being "glorified" right after Judas leaves?
- 2. What do you imagine was going through the disciples' minds when Jesus said He'd be leaving soon?
- 3. Jesus calls them "little children." How does that make you feel about His relationship with them—and with us?
- 4. What do you think it means to follow Jesus when you don't know exactly where He's going?
- 5. What's different about loving like Jesus compared to just being "nice" or "kind"?
- 6. Can you think of a time someone loved you like Jesus did? What impact did it have?
- 7. What do you think makes loving others hard—even people close to us?
- 8. How could your love for others show people who Jesus is?
- 9. Jesus says love will prove we're His disciples. Do you think the Church lives that out well today? Why or why not?
- 10. What's one thing Jesus' love has taught you about your worth or identity?
- 11. If Jesus were physically walking out today, what would you say or ask before He left?

# Challenges

- 1. Do Radical Love: Find one meaningful way to love someone unconditionally this week—especially someone you might usually avoid or disagree with.
- 2. Be the Proof: Think about your online presence. How can you make sure your words and actions reflect the love Jesus talks about? Make one change.
- 3. Sit With the Silence: Spend 10 minutes a day this week sitting in silence with Jesus. Ask Him how He wants you to love others more like Him.
