Child Abuse Prevention and Reporting Policy Assessment

- The Pennsylvania Department of Human Services operates a statewide toll-free system for receiving reports of suspected child abuse known as (a) KidLine, (b) ChildLine, (c) KidHelp, (d) ChildHelp.
